

Team Sheets



Team sheets are required for all fixtures.

When receiving a team sheet please ensure it is:

- a) Readable
- b) Has a full given and family name (*ie no initials, nicknames or single surname/given name/AN Other*).
- c) There is a name for each player.
- d) The shirt numbers (if worn) match the names. (*A verbal confirmation with the captain is sufficient*)
- e) The nominated front row replacements **must** be identified on the team sheet prior to kick off.
- f) Only the number of FR replacements as directed by the IRFU is permitted. (*Refer to front row cover guidance note*)
- g) You retain the sheet in a safe place for 2 weeks.

If A, B or C are not in effect the team are in contravention of the competitions regulations and are liable to sanction. Sanctions are significant for the clubs and are designed to educate them not to impede the system. When there is an allegation of an illegal player participating for a team it is these lists which are requested by the branch. The same list is your reference when submitting a yellow or red card report and if reporting injuries. Referees are urged to get the lists BEFORE they allow the game to commence.
